BEUC joins European network to fight financial exclusion

BEUC, the European Consumer's Organisation, is strengthening its activities in its fight against financial exclusion by joining The European Financial Inclusion Network (EFIN). EFIN is a coalition of European stakeholders (institutions and individuals) involved in financial inclusion, including public institutions, trade unions, NGOs, universities and research institutes, consumer protection organisations and bank associations.

For consumers, it is key to have access to financial services in order to be integrated in society and to live a normal social and economic life. By teaming up with other associations and institutions from all over Europe, BEUC has increased its leverage to raise awareness of this issue and to convince the European legislator and national governments to make sure that basic banking services should be available and accessible to all EU consumers everywhere in the EU.
