1 Public financing

needs to be innovative:
guarantee funds for de-risking,
revolving funds to address up-front costs
(replenished with the grants,
disbursed once the works are completed).



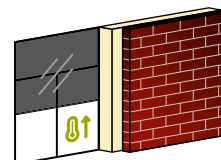
Private financing

**needs to be combined with
enabling public financial instruments**
that act as steppingstones
for low-income households
to access funding.



2 Energy Building Benchmarks

will help local authorities engage
with multi-unit owners and ensure the smooth
implementation of retrofit programmes.



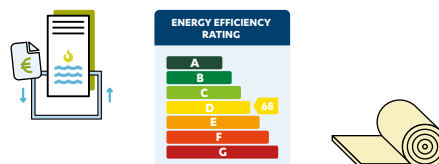
3 Minimum Energy Performance Standards

should be in place ensuring all multi-unit
buildings are at least D-rated by 2040.



4 ONE-STOP-SHOPS

need to be properly funded and operational
for consumers to be supported and
confident enough to step in!



5 Energy Performance Certificates (EPC)

need to clearly indicate via the D rating
whether a home has enough insulation
to be "heat pump ready" so that the
investment is cost optimal.
